unteer to take in a family of Syrian refugees. I can't think of a better way to learn about Muslim people than to have them as houseguests. My goal would be to help them get employment and an apartment so that that they could become selfsufficient.

The reason why I would do this is because my faith tells me that I should. Jesus said that if I welcome a stranger, then I welcome Jesus himself (Matthew 25:35). And the author of the letter to the Hebrews says, "Let mutual love continue. Do not neglect to show hospitality to strangers for by doing that some have entertained angels without knowing it" (Hebrews

13:1).

In fact, it is hard for me to accept that any Bible-believing Christian would not be eager to join me in hosting a family of refugees after reading the passage in Luke chapter 6 verses 32-36 that paraphrasing says, be merciful to people whether they are the same as you or not; do good, expecting nothing in return.

My understanding of Christ's teaching tells me that the best way to diffuse radical Islam is to practice radical hospitality and charitable love toward all Muslims. And if fear is what makes the

please remember that God does not give us the spirit of fear; but of power, and of love, and of a sound mind (2Timothy 1:7).

A mentor of mine once told me that God is love. He also said that the opposite of love is not hate, but fear.

In fact, fear is the objective of terrorism. I refuse to let terrorism win. I will choose love and reject fear. Loving Muslim refugees by bringing them into my home seems like a good start.
